## Three Most Important Things to being found in Yahuweh

- 1. Yahweh Exists
- 2. Yahweh reveals His Name and desires Personal Relationship
- 3. Yahweh is always Trustworthy, Reliable and Unfailing
- 1. In this discussion where the meanings behind names is emphasized, let's examine the most important ones. Yahuweh gave Moses the basis of His name: hayah. It means "I Exist." "I Was, I Am, and I Will Be." Yahuweh's name answers the most important question man can ask, for if God exists, knowing Him becomes central to understanding our existence. Therefore we should not be surprised that hayah is in turn related to chay, the Hebrew word for "life and restoration." And that is because Yahuweh is the source of eternal life. In paleo Hebrew the yod, or "Y" was a vowel consonant representing the "Ya" sound in English. The "w's" in Yahuwshuwa' (יְהֹ וֹשְׁיִי) designated the vowel "u" in paleo Hebrew. And the "'", representing the Hebrew ayin, signified the vowel "a." Thus, transliterated into English, the name of the Messiah and the prototype for Him, is "Yahushua." And as I'm sure you've noticed, the first three letters in Yahuweh and Yahushua are the same: YHW, pronounced "Yahu." The "shua" suffix of the Savior's name is from yasha' (יִשִׁיִ), meaning "salvation or savior." Therefore, God has but one name Yahuweh. Yahushua simply defines what He has done for us.
- 2. Yada' is the Hebrew word for: "to know in relational sense, to recognize and experience." Yahweh, or more correctly, Yahuweh, is God's name. His personal and proper name means "I Am," and "I Exist." Therefore, Yadaing Yahweh is an invitation "to know Yahweh" and "to understand our existence." He created this kind of relationship, Beriyth/Covenant relationship with his Yahhuwdym the adopted Gentiles.
- 3. "Yahushua said, 'I Am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father but by Me." (John 14:6) "I and the Father are One." (John 10:30) "Yahushua said to them, 'Before Abraham was born, I Am." (John 8:58) Consistent with Yahuweh's Old Covenant revelation through His prophet named Salvation, the Renewed Covenant confirms that we must know and trust Yahweh to be saved: "For God so loved the world that He gave His unique and only Son, that whoever relies upon him should not perish, but have eternal life. For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world but so the world should be saved through Him. He who trusts Him is not judged." (John 3:16-18) The choice for most is between eternal life and death - not between life and eternal death. Those who rely on Yahuweh's redemptive provision are not judged. By being born from above in His Set Apart Spirit, they are anointed in His Garment of Light, becoming innocent and guiltless - perfect in God's eyes. Those who are born from above become one with God; their soul and His Spirit are forever joined in the holiest of marriages. (This is the subject of the Song of Songs.) As such, we live forever in His presence. This is eternal life.
